

1. Location
2. Chronic user with muscle weakness. What would be found on an ABG?
3. The person that uses levothyroxine with hypotension, metabolic acidosis, hyperkalemia, and skin hyperpigmentation
4. MVA 2 days ago and persistent hypotension unresponsive to pressors
5. Asthma patient that has used his inhaler multiple times a day for the past week
6. 2 ppd/35 year smoker with chronic respiratory symptoms
7. Lots of itching in a 7 year old within the antecubital fossa. There are visible red patches on the skin

As an aside, associated genetic mutation:

As an aside, recurrent infections (2):

8. 3 hour history of profound SOB and markedly decreased PaCO₂ in an asthmatic
9. 2 day history of increased sputum production in a long term smoker
10. Increased nasal blood expression, anosmia, OSA style symptoms, and daily removal of encrusted lesions from the nose (could be in an individual that takes aspirin chronically)
11. Difficult to control asthma + high IgE + pulmonary interstitial infiltrates
12. African American female with dry cough and serum Ca of 13.4 mg/dl
13. Profound hypoxia with pulmonary interstitial infiltrates in an IV drug user. His PaO₂ is 59
14. Skin blisters that rupture easily with gentle pressure
15. Management of the patient in #3
16. 3 day history of significant bloody diarrhea in a 23 yo M who has over the last 6 weeks had increased stool production. He also has jaundice

As an aside, what are the others???

17. 4 day old newborn with hypotension, bicarb of 5, K of 6, and skin hyperpigmentation
18. 33 yo F with chronic fatigue, amenorrhea with infertility, elevated AST/ALT, and positive ANA

19. Hct of 39%, WBC 6000/mm³, and plts of 26000 3 weeks after a URI
20. Proximal shoulder weakness and pain in a 45 yo F
21. Right sided visual difficulty with upper facial pain on the same side
22. Difficulty climbing stairs and lifting objects with a CPK of 5000
23. Eye pain, redness, and blurry vision in a teenager with a 7 week history of R knee pain
24. 3 hour history of significant eye pain in a 35 yo F with a history of urinary incontinence and leg weakness that resolved after a few weeks
25. The steroid + cyclophosphamide trio:
26. Nuchal rigidity and fever with CSF studies disclosing gram positive organisms in chains
27. 75 yo F with profuse groin itching and vulva thinning
28. MCC of excess
29. A1c of 7.8% in a patient with a 2 year history of severe asthma
30. Difficulty reading signs at night in a patient with a 2 year history of severe asthma
31. Severe LLE pain with bullous changes and a rapidly expanding boundary
32. 2 day history of significant SOB and pulmonary interstitial infiltrates in a 25 yo F with a history of severe asthma
33. Severe RUE pain and discontinuity after hitting a door handle
34. Significant bloody diarrhea leading to death in a 25 year old F with a history of poorly controlled SLE who traveled to a foreign country for spring break
35. Hearing voices with unusual behavior
36. Face and neck
37. Difficulty climbing stairs with a CPK of 50
38. Frequent accidents and car sideswipes
39. Burning chest pain and GI bleeding
40. Painful swallowing in a 22 yo F using inhaled fluticasone chronically
41. Painful contractions at 32 weeks

42. WBC of 25000/mm³ in an individual being treated for an asthma exacerbation
43. Chemotherapeutic regimens
44. Skin changes
45. Insidious R sided hip pain with a limp
46. 71 year old male with a 24 hr history of diffuse LE weakness, a positive babinski, and pinpoint low back tenderness. His PSA is 10 fold the upper limit of normal.
47. 12 hr history of significant left elbow pain and redness in an obese, unhealthy male

As an aside, the other 2nd line:

48. 2 year old child with failure to thrive, muscle weakness, K of 2.5, elevated blood pressures, bicarb of 34 and decreased aldosterone/renin
49. Classic CBC anomaly in the individual with hypotension, hyperkalemia, and skin hyperpigmentation
50. Eye swelling in a 33 yo M with Afib
